#### **General Guidelines**

- As a general rule, ski and snowboard equipment with bindings is allowed for use at Diamond Peak. If there are not bindings, it is not allowed.
- If a device is being used as an accessibility device, it is approved for use.

## **Alpine Skis**



Skis with normal alpine bindings

#### Snowboards



Snowboard with bindings. Only one foot must be strapped in while loading, riding and unloading the lift.

Short skis that have bindings

## **Adaptive Equipment**



Any adaptive piece of equipment that is designed for adaptive skiing/riding is allowed. This includes, but is not limited to sit skis and ski bikes.

## **Snow Skates**



Skateboard with mini-snowboard attached to the bottom. No bindings, therefore not allowed.

# **Pow Surfers**



Snowboard with no bindings, therefore not allowed.

#### **Snow Decks**



Skateboard with slick surface on the bottom. No bindings, therefore not allowed.

#### **Sleds**



Sleds are not allowed at Diamond Peak at any time.

# **Babies in Backpacks/Front Packs**



Not allowed on lifts or ski runs.

Children must have their own ski/snowboard equipment and sit on the lift next to the parent.
